The 32 trilingual historical markers (Spanish, French and English) celebrate the unique heritage of Iberia Parish and designate significant historic buildings and events in New Iberia. These markers replace original markers which were presented by the members of Iberia Cultural Resources Association in its early years.

ORAL HISTORY PROJECT

In the Cajun tradition of storytelling, Iberia Cultural Resources collected and published *"New Iberia – What Can't Be Lost,"* which features oral histories of residents who grew up in Iberia Parish to document and preserve the memories in an area that has French and Spanish roots. Residents were invited to submit memorable stories and anecdotes that shed light on times gone by and give perspective to places and events that have been an integral part of life in Iberia Parish.
